

SCHOOL FEES

As far as possible the Fees are inclusive. They include exercise and text books, library and lunches. A charge may be made for any books or property which are lost or damaged. The only additional charges are for school outings and for optional extras (e.g. instrumental tuition and clubs.); details of these are available on request.

There is a non-refundable Registration Fee of £50 and, normally one term before a pupil joins the School, a Confirmation of Entry Fee of £200 is required. This amount is credited against the fees for the final term at the completion of the Preparatory School Course or earlier, at the discretion of the Governors, in such special circumstances as the family moving away from the area.

Fees are due for payment by the first day of term. Interest is charged on Accounts not paid by the first day of term at the rate of 75p per day per child, invoices for the interest will be raised weekly whilst the Account remains uncleared.

If a pupil is withdrawn from the School a full term's notice in writing must be given; otherwise parents will be required to pay the full fees for the following term.

A reduction of fees is offered to brothers/sisters at the rate of £100.00 per term each for two in the school together, £150 per term for the third and subsequent brothers/sisters in the school together. The same reductions are offered to sons/daughters of Old Boys, Clergy and Missionaries, but no one can receive reductions for more than one reason. These reductions are only applicable for full time attendance.

Means tested bursaries are available for 7+ entry, more details on request.

All pupils are automatically covered by a **Personal Accident Insurance Scheme** at no additional charge. This insurance provides for substantial benefit in the event of accident and pupils are covered at all times, both at home and school.
